### INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

### **Use Aseptic Technique**

### **DUALCAP SOLO™ INSTALLATION**

- Holding the Dark Blue DualCap Solo, grasp the foil tab and remove.
- 2. Twist the Dark Blue DualCap Solo onto the male luer in clockwise direction.

### TO REMOVE:

- 1. Using two hands, grasp the male luer and twist the Dark Blue DualCap Solo counter clockwise.
- 2. Reconnect the IV line.
- 3. Discard DualCap Solo per institutional guidelines after

A new Dark Blue DualCap Solo should be placed on all male luer connectors each time the IV line is disconnected and not in use.

### INDICATIONS FOR USE

When left in place for 30 seconds, the Dark Blue DualCap Solo disinfects male luer connectors; thereafter the caps provide a physical barrier to contamination up to 7 days under normal conditions if not removed.

### **PRECAUTIONS**

- · Do not use if package is broken, torn or punctured.
- · Do not re-use. Do not resterilize.
- Follow instructions for use and institutional guidelines for disposal.
- Do not store at extreme conditions.
